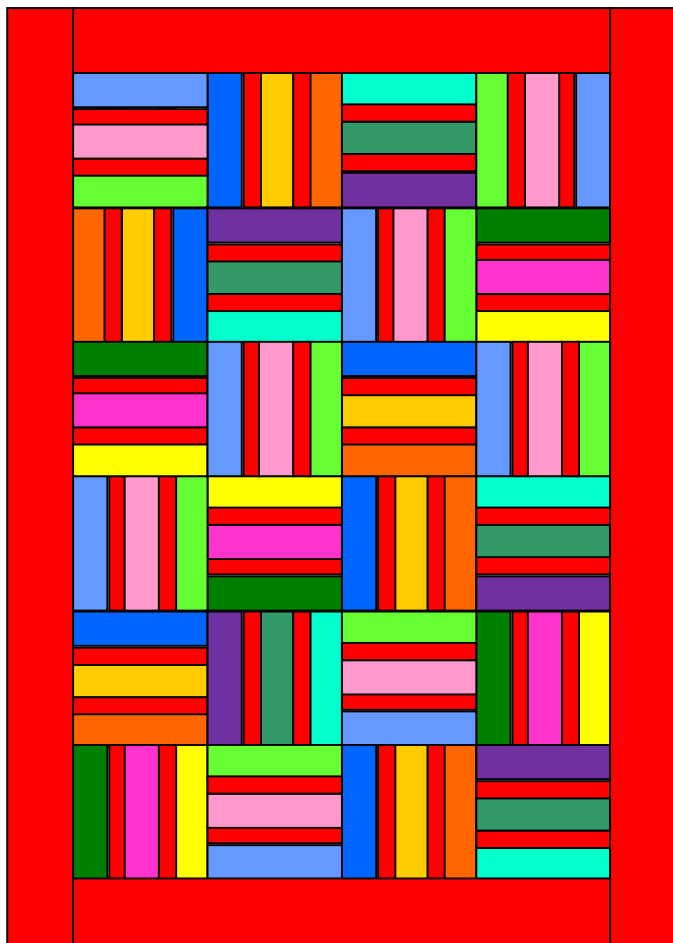


Worm Quilt – Skinny Rails

(40" x 56")



Yardage

Worms 18 2 1/2" assorted selvage to selvage strips
 Rails, Border, Binding 1 5/8 yds (54" - 18"rails, 23" sashing, 13" binding)
 Backing 1 3/4 yds

Cut

Rails 12 strips @ 1 1/2"
 Border 5 strips @ 4 1/2"
 Binding 5 strips @ 2 1/2"

Sew

Sew a worm, rail, worm, rail, worm together along the long side. Press all seams in same direction. Cross cut the resulting strata at 8 1/2".



Repeat with remaining worms and rails for a total of 24 blocks.

Alternating the direction of the stripes, arrange the blocks into a 4 by 6 grid. (See picture at left.)

Sew the blocks together in rows, then sew the rows together.

Sew on the top and bottom borders, then the sides. Quilt and bind.
