

Sierra Quilt Guild Block of the Month February 2019 Puss in the Corner

The completed block measures 9 ½" x 9 ½" unfinished (9" x 9" finished)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric A Background – White on White print

Twenty (20) 2" x 2" squares

Four (4) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles

Fabric B – Light colored Valentine's Day or heart print

One (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" square

Four (4) 2" x 2" squares

Fabric C – Dark colored coordinating fabric

Four (4) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles

Eight (8) 2" x 2" squares



Step 1: Corner 4-patch

A: Take eight (8) of the background 2" squares and sew them together to make four pairs.

B: Take four (4) of the Fabric B 2" squares and sew them to four (4) of the background 2" squares to make four sets.

C: Sew the sets from step 1A and 1B together to make the corner 4-patch sets.



Step 2: Flying Geese Units

Make four (4) flying geese units using the 2" x 3 ½" Fabric C rectangles.

Make four (4) flying geese units using the 2" x 3 ½" background fabric rectangles.




Flying Geese Units:

1. Place a Fabric C 2" square on one end of a background 2" x 3 ½" rectangle. Sew a line from the center of the rectangle, diagonally through the square to the opposite corner.
2. Trim off the little triangle on the outer side of the seam. Press open.
3. Repeat on the other side to complete one Flying Geese unit.
4. Repeat this process with the background 2" squares and the Fabric C 2" x 3 ½" rectangles. You should end up with eight (8) Flying Geese units (pictured above)

(OVER)

Step3 : Assemble the block



Lay your pieced units out like this.



Sew the pieced units together like this



Continue to sew the pieced units together until you end up with three "rows"



Sew the three rows together, matching seams. Press. Trim the block to 9 1/2" square.
