

More Info February Block of the Month

Thank you very much for the opportunity to be the Chair of the Block of the Month for 2017. The block this month is a Disappearing Nine Patch. It is named this way because you first create a Nine Patch, which is 9 blocks of the same size sewn into a square shape. Then that Nine Patch "disappears" when it is cut, rearranged a little, and then sewn back together again. Easy and fun!

This particular pattern uses Black on White fabric, which appears as basically white fabric with a black design, and White on Black, which appears mostly as black fabric with some white design. It also uses one 4" square of Kaffe Fassett fabric in each block. I am providing your choice of a Kaffe square of fabric for each block you intend to complete, if you want one. The winner of the drawing in February will also receive enough of those Kaffe 4" squares to end up with 50 blocks. That means that if the winner receives 15 completed blocks in February, they will also receive 35 Kaffe 4" squares to either use making more blocks, use in a border, use in another project - whatever they want!

I hope you enjoy making this block. If you have any suggestions about the kind of blocks you would like to see in future Block of the Months, please let me know.
