

Lisa's second set of President's Blocks

Lisa requested Log Cabin Blocks - Half Black and White with the other side bright colors

It is to be a 12 ½" unfinished block (will trim to 12" by Lisa)

Start with a 3 ½" center – Red (Represents home and hearth)

All strips to be cut 2" wide

If you are familiar with Log Cabin Blocks, you know that your first log/strip will be $2 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " of either the black/white or a bright color.

You then do a second log of the same color. The length of the second log/strip will be 2 x 5. And so on

Cutting instructions:

Ultimately you will need:

$Log 1 = 2 \times 3-1/2$	Black/White	$Log 7 = 2 \times 8$	Bright Color
$Log 2 = 2 \times 5$	Black/White	$Log 8 = 2 \times 9-1/2$	Bright Color
$Log 3 = 2 \times 5$	Bright Color	$Log 9 = 2 \times 9-1/2$	Black/White
$Log 4 = 2 \times 6-1/2$	Bright Color	$Log 10 = 2 \times 11$	Black/White
$Log 5 = 2 \times 6-1/2$	Black/White	$Log 11 = 2 \times 11$	Bright Color
$Log 6 = 2 \times 8$	Black/White	$Log 12 = 2 \times 12-1/2$	Bright Color

If you choose to start with the bright color instead of the black/white, just reverse the captions above.
