

# Sierra Quilt Guild Block of the Month

## April, 2019

### Modern Stripes

The completed block measures 11" x 11" unfinished (10 1/2" x 10 1/2" finished)

#### **Fabric Requirements:**

**Fabric A – Blue Paisley** *This Fabric will be supplied at the March Guild Meeting.*

One (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip subcut into three (3) 1 1/2" x 13" strips.

**Fabric B – White or light-read print**

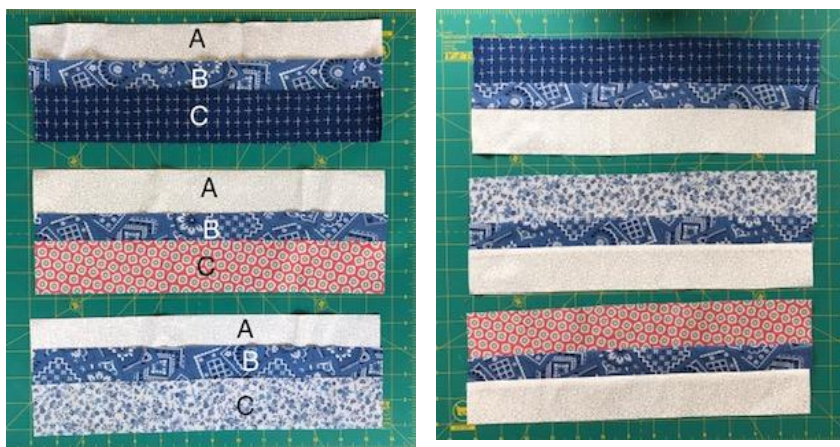
Three (3) 1 3/4" x 13" strips

**Fabric C1, C2, C3 – Three different medium-read prints**

C1 – One (1) 1 3/4" x 13" strip

C2 – One (1) 1 3/4" x 13" strip

C3 – One (1) 1 3/4" x 13" strip



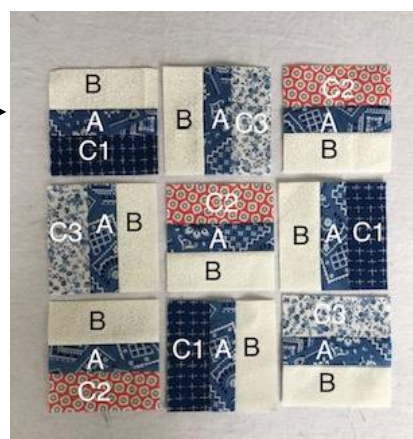
#### **Step 1: Sew Strips together:**

Begin by sewing three (3) strip sets:  
B/A/C1, B/A/C2 and B/A/C3

Press open.

#### **Step 2: Subcut the strip sets:**

Subcut each strip sets into three (3) 4" x 4" segments.  
You should end up with twelve (12) 4" x 4" segments.  
Arrange the segments like shown in the photo.



#### **Step 3: Sew the segments and rows:**

Sew the 4" x 4" segments together in rows 1, 2 and 3.  
Sew the 3 rows together.  
Press. Trim block to 11" x 11" unfinished.
