

Sierra Quilt Guild Block of the Month  
May, 2019  
Connecting Corners

The completed block measures 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished (10" x 10" finished)

**Fabric Requirements:**

**Fabric A:** (White or light-read fabric)

Four (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares, one (1) 1 1/2" x 14" strip, four (4) 3" x 3" squares

**Fabric B:** (Something that blends well with Supplied Fabric D)

Four (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares, four (4) 3" x 3" squares

**Fabric C:** (Something that blends well with Supplied Fabric D)

Five (5) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

**Fabric D: SUPPLIED**

One (1) 1 1/2" x 14" strip

**A/B Half Square Triangle Units:**

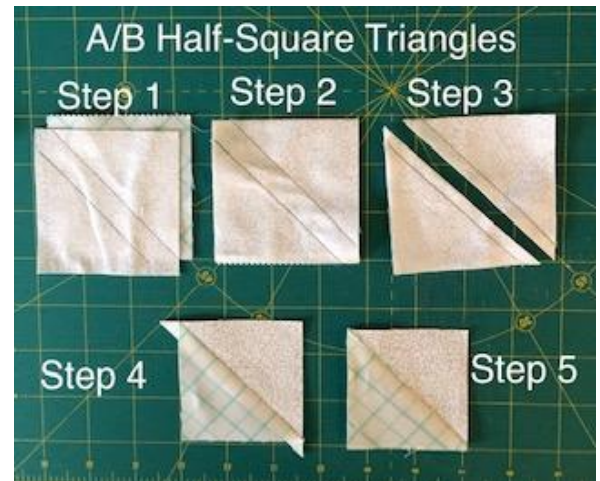
Step 1: Draw two diagonal lines on the wrong side of each Fabric B 3" x 3" square as shown.

Step 2: Place one Fabric A 3" x 3" square and one Fabric B 3" x 3" square right sides together and stitch on the drawn diagonal lines.

Step 3: Cut between the stitched lines.

Step 4: Press open.

Step 5: Trim A/B unit to 2 1/2" square. You will need eight (8) A/B half-square triangles.

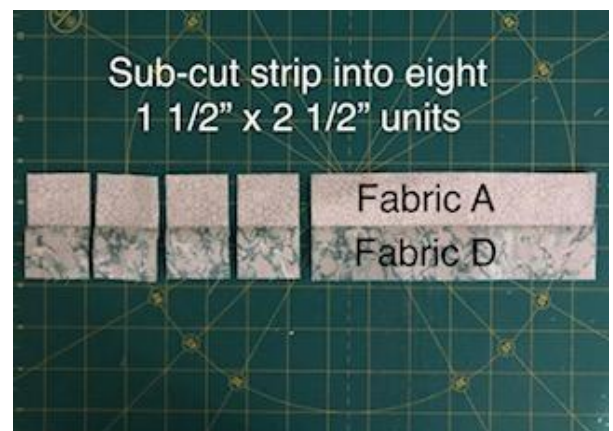


**Prepping for the A/D Corner Units:**

Step 1: With right sides together, sew Fabric A 1 1/2" x 14" strip to Fabric D 1 1/2" x 14" strip.

Step 2: Press open.

Step 3: Sub-cut the strip into 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" units. You will need eight (8) units.



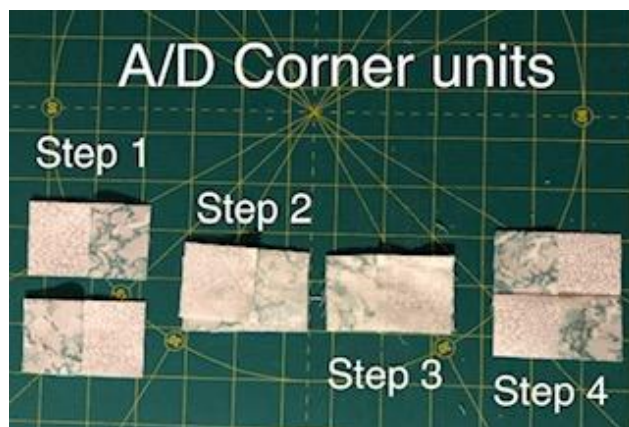
### Assembling the A/D Corner Units:

Step 1: Take two (2) of the A/D units and lay them out as shown here. →

Step 2: Put the two units right sides together making sure that the Fabric D sides are opposite each other.

Step 3: Stitch.

Step 4: Press open and trim to 2 ½" x 2 ½" square.



### Assembling the Block:

Using a design wall or flat surface, lay the block units together as shown below:



### Stitching the Block:

Stitch the block together row by row. Alternate the direction you press your seams from row to row.



### Finishing the Block:

Stitch the rows together being sure to "nest" the seam allowances as you go.

Press row seams down. Trim block to 10 ½" x 10 ½" square.
