

# Sierra Quilt Guild Block of the Month

## June, 2019

### Canning Fun

The completed block measures 8 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished (8" x 10" finished)

#### Fabric Requirements:

**Fabric A: SUPPLIED** (Yellow background)

One (1) 9" x 9" square subcut into:

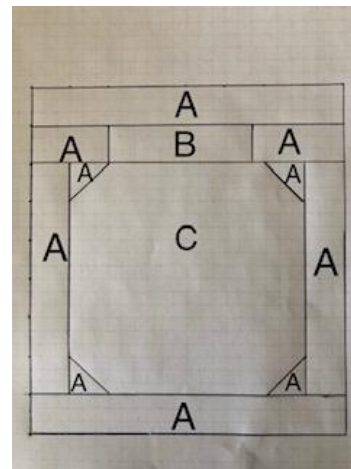
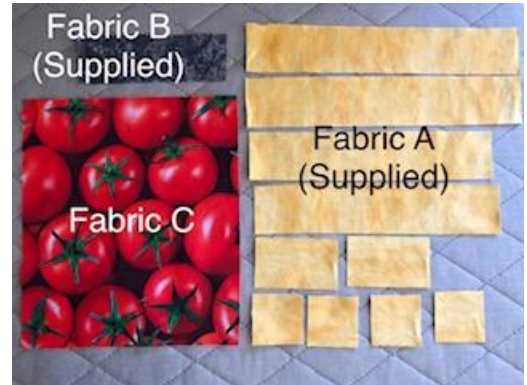
- Two (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips
- Two (2) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" strips
- Four (4) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares
- Two (2) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

**Fabric B: SUPPLIED** (Gray "lid")

One (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip

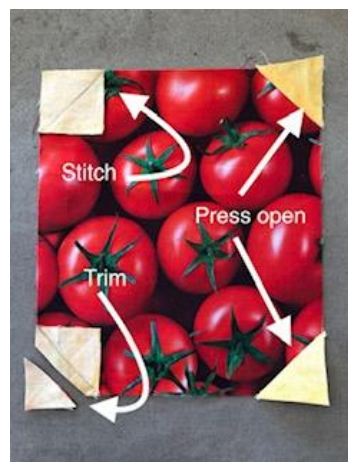
**Fabric C:** (A fun "canning" fabric)

One (1) 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangle



#### Step 1: A/C Unit:

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the **Fabric A** 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. Stitch the **Fabric A** squares to the corners of the **Fabric B** 6 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangle. Stitch on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the stitch line. Press open. Finished **A/B** unit should measure 6 1/2" x 7 1/2".



### **Step 2: Attaching side strips:**

Sew one (1) **Fabric A** 1 ½" x 7 ½" strip to each side of the **A/C unit**.  
Press seams out.



### **Step 3: Making the A/B unit:**

Sew one (1) **Fabric A** 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle to each side of the **Fabric B** 1 ½" x 4 ½" strip.  
Press seams towards center.

### **Step 4: Block Assembly:**

Sew the **A/B unit** to the top of the **A/C unit**.

Sew one (1) **Fabric A** 1 ½" x 8 ½" strip to the top and the bottom of the **A/B-A/C unit**.

Press and trim block to 8 ½" x 10 ½".
