

Sierra Quilt Guild Block of the Month July 2018 Roses Galore

The completed block measures 10 1/2" X 11 1/2" finished (111" X 12" unfinished). All seams sewn at 1/4".

Fabric Requirements

Feature Block: Block 6" X 7"

Inner Border: 1 1/2" strip 30" long, cut into 2 pieces 7" and 2 pieces 8"

Flange: 1" strip 34" long, cut into 2 pieces 8" and 2 pieces 9"

Outer Border: 2" strip 40" long, cut into 2 pieces 9" and 2 pieces 11"

Step One - Add inner border

Stitch 7" inner border pieces to the sides of the block. Press seams open. Stitch 8" inner border pieces to the top and bottom of the block. Press seams open.



Step Two - Add flange

Press flange pieces in half lengthwise. Pin 8" pieces to the sides, raw edges together and folded edge towards center. Pin the 9" pieces to the sides, raw edges together with folded edge towards center. Stitch 1/8" from edge around block to secure the flange. Stitching the flange down, rather than pinning the flange in place, seems to yield a better result.

Step Three - Add outer border

Stitch the 9" border pieces to the sides of the block. Press seams towards the outer border. Stitch the 11" outer border to the top and bottom of the block. Press seams towards the outer border.
