

Sierra Quilt Guild Block of the Month

August 2018

Cowgirl Boot

The completed block measures 8" X 7" finished (8 1/2" X 7 1/2" unfinished). All seams sewn 1/4".

Fabric Requirements

Boot Shaft: Piece 4" X 6 1/2"

Boot toe box: Piece 2 1/2" X 5 1/2"; 2 squares 1" X 1"

Heel: 2 1/2" square

Background: Piece 4" X 6 1/2"; 5 squares 1" X 1"

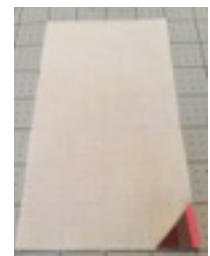
Step One - Prepare toe box

Draw diagonal lines on two background squares. Position across both lower corners of the toe box. Stitch on diagonal lines. Trim and press away from toe box.



Step Two - Prepare Boot shaft

Draw diagonal lines on two background squares and the wrong side of one of the toe box squares. Position the background squares across the upper corners. Position the toe box square on the lower left corner of the boot shaft piece. Stitch on 3 diagonal lines. Trim and press away from the boot shaft piece.



Step Three - Prepare background piece

Draw a diagonal line on the remaining toe box square. Position across lower right corner of the background piece. Stitch on the diagonal line. Trim and press away from background piece.

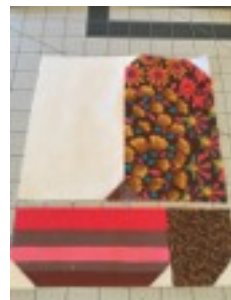


Step Four - Prepare heel piece

Draw a diagonal line on the remaining background square. Position across lower right corner of the heel piece. Stitch on the diagonal line. Trim and press away from background piece.

Step Five - Stitch Boot Pieces

Stitch the long edge of the background piece to the long edge of the boot shaft. Stitch the short edge of the toe box piece to the heel piece. Stitch the top part of the boot to the bottom part of the boot.
