



*Sierra Quilt Guild  
Block of the Month July 2016  
Summer Sailboat*

This block measures 5" x 6" finished (5 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished).

**Colors:** Patriotic Red, White and Blue!

**Cutting:** Blue Water: (1) 5" square  
(1) 1 ½" x 4" rectangle  
(1) 1 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle  
(2) 1 ½" squares  
Red Boat: (1) 1 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle  
White Sail: (1) 5" square

**Construction:**

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the (2) 1 ½" blue squares. With right sides together, sew along the line to each end of red boat fabric. Trim seam to ¼"; press to boat.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 5" blue square. With right sides together of the blue and white 5" squares, sew ¼" from the diagonal line on both sides of the line. Cut apart on the line. Press seam to blue. Square up to 4 ½".

3. Stitch water to sail and water to boat; *make sure to match correct lengths!*



4. Stitch sail/water unit to boat/water unit. Press seam to boat. Let recipient square up.

**Consider This:** *You will have one sail leftover when you are done. Why not cut an extra red boat, and from the water fabric cut two extra rectangles and two extra small squares? You will end up with two cute sailboats!*
