



Sierra Quilt Guild
Block of the Month June 2016
Windows

This block measures 6" x 12" finished (6 ½" x 12 ½" unfinished).

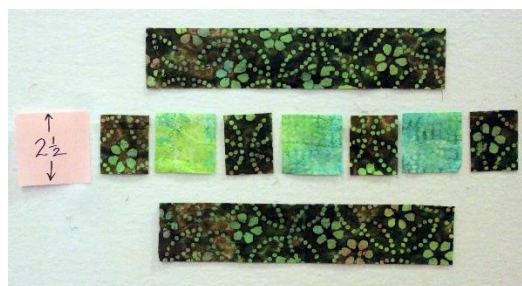
Colors: Batiks in Blues, Greens and Turquoise. Background: batik of choice, light or dark. Windows: coordinating batik, use light with a dark background or dark with a light background.

Consider This: *This is a great block to make two at a time. It takes one 2 ½" strip by WOF (width of fabric) from two colors to make two blocks. You can layer the two strips and cut the background and the windows at the same time for both blocks. Follow construction instructions.*

Cutting: Background: (2) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips
 (4) 2 ½" x 2" rectangles
 Windows: (3) 2 ½" squares

Construction:

1. Lay the center of the block out as shown below, *being careful to have the length of the 2 ½" x 2" rectangles going in the correct direction.* Sew seams and press towards the dark.



2. Sew the 2 ½" x 12" background strips to each side as shown. Press long seams towards outside strips. Let recipient square up as results will vary by sewer.
