



Sierra Quilt Guild
Block of the Month September 2016
1930s Split 9-Patch

This block measures 8 ½" finished (9" unfinished).

Colors: 1930s reproduction fabrics: white, main color and coordinating color.

Cutting: White: (4) 3 ½" squares
Main color: (4) 3 ½" squares
Coordinating color: (1) 3 ½" square

Construction:

1. Sew into three rows as shown below. Press seams away from white.
2. Sew rows together as shown in Step 1.
3. Cut block in half both horizontally and vertically (a rotary cutting mat is useful). If you have sewn and cut accurately, you now have four squares each 4 ¾" square.
4. Rearrange upper left and lower right blocks as shown by rotating twice.
5. Stitch top two blocks together. Stitch bottom two blocks together.
6. Stitch top to bottom. Let recipient square up.
