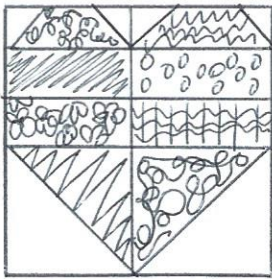


Block of the Month February 2015

Follow Your "Scrappy" Heart



This block measures 12" square finished (12 1/2" square unfinished). For the heart use scrappy fabrics in bright red, hot pink or purple/violet.

Cutting:

From three or more prints:

6 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

2 - 6 7/8" squares

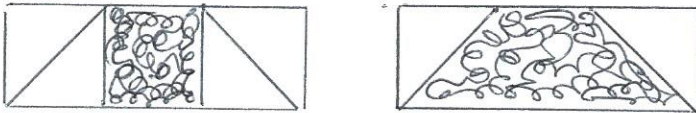
From white, or mostly white with coordinating color, background fabric:

4 - 2 1/2" squares

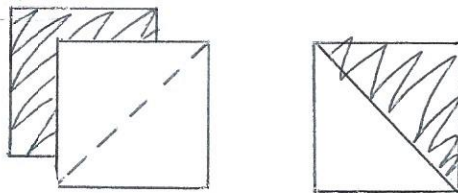
2 - 6 7/8" squares

Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on back of all six background squares.

With right sides together, lay two of the squares on the ends of one of the 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the corners to 1/4" from the seam and press to the corner. Repeat for one more 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" piece.



Place right sides together of one 6 7/8" background piece with one print same size. Sew 1/4" seam on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the line and press seam to corner. Repeat with second 6 7/8" background piece and same size print. (Use the two "extra" squares to make a second block!)



Lay out the block according to the picture. Piece each row, sewing left to right using 1/4" seam. Press top row to right, second row to left, third row to right and fourth row to left. Sew the rows together, top to bottom, using 1/4" seam. Press first and second rows down. Press third row up. Trim dog ears.
