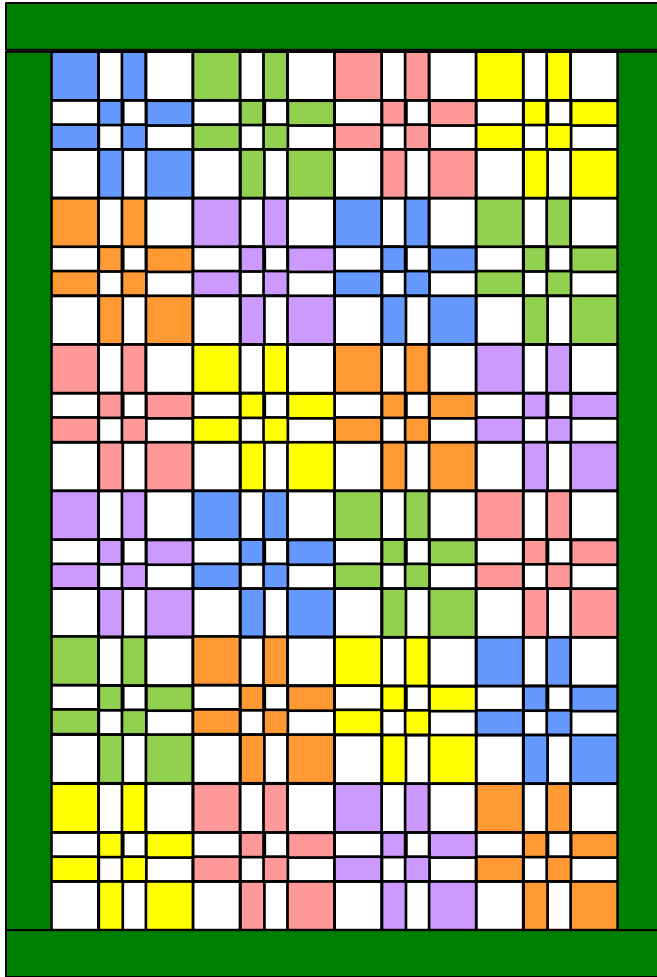


Interlock (48" x 68")



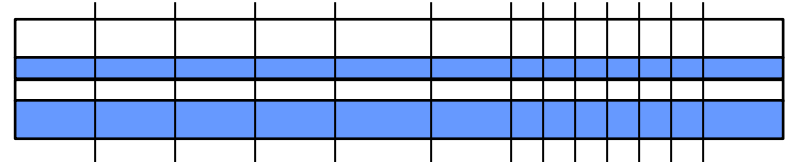
Yardage

Prints	1/4 yd (6") of 8 fabrics – cut selvage to selvage strips : 1 @ 4" 1 @ 2"
Background	1 1/2 yds (48") – cut selvage to selvage strips: 8 @ 4" 8 @ 2"
Border	1 yd (27" cut into 6 strips @ 4 1/2")
Binding	1/2 yd (15" cut into 6 strips @ 2 1/2")
Backing	3 yds

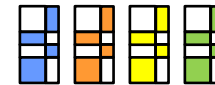
Sew:

1. Select one print and sew a 4" Background, a 2" print, a 2" background, and a matching 4" print along the long sides. Press all seams toward the 4" background strip. Repeat with the other 7 prints.

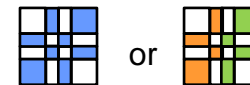
2. From each strip set, crosscut 6 units @ 4" and 6 units @ 2".



3. Using the same 2 prints, flip the smaller unit and sew it to a larger unit. All seams should "nest". Repeat until you have 48 rectangles..



4. At this point, you have two options. You can match two rectangles of the same print to make a block or you can mix the prints. After you have sewn together pairs of rectangles, you will have 24 blocks.



5. Sew the blocks into a 4 x 6 grid.
6. Sew border strips to the top and bottom. Sew two border strips together and sew to one side. Repeat for other side. Quilt and bind.
