


June 2014 Block of the Month

Evening Star with Pinwheel

12" finished block



Fabric Colors: Blue & Orange with a neutral (tan, white, etc.) background fabric.

Option 1

- 1 = Blue Fabric
- 2 = Orange Fabric
- 3 = Background Fabric

Option 2

- 1 = Orange Fabric
- 2 = Blue Fabric
- 3 = Background Fabric

Cutting Instructions

Fabric 1 = Cut 2 squares each 3-7/8" and divide in half diagonally once

Fabric 2 = Cut 4 squares each 3-7/8" - leave as squares

Fabric 3 = Cut 1 square 7-1/4"

Cut 2 squares each 3-7/8" and divide in half diagonally once

Cut 4 squares each 3-1/2" - leave as squares

Sewing Sequence

Flying Geese Units: following steps 1 thru 4 below, use the 7-1/4" sq. of #3 and the four 3-7/8" sqs. of #2 for one set of 4 geese units. In the diagrams below, blue = the 7-1/4" square & white = the 3-7/8" squares.


1. **Diagram 1 below:** Having right sides together, place two 3-7/8" squares on the 7-1/4" square. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn line.

2. **Diagram 2 below:** Cut the units apart on the drawn line and press toward the small #2 fabric triangles.

3. **Diagram 3 below:** Having right sides together, place a 3-7/8" square on each of the units from step 2, draw a diagonal line as shown and sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn line.

4. **Diagram 4 below:** Cut the units apart on the drawn line and press toward the small #2 fabric triangles.

You will now have 4 Geese units.




Pinwheel Blocks

1. Sew the #1 & #3 triangles together into squares. Press to the #3 fabric.

2. Using the units from Step 1, sew 2 sets as follows: Sew from top down to seam allowance, stop at seam allowance & backstitch.


3. Sew the Step 2 units together as shown. Press to fabric #1 on each side of the center and the center will fan open flat.



4. Sew a #3 square to each side of 2 of the geese units. Press to the #3 fabric.

5. Sew the remaining 2 geese units to each side of the Pinwheel block. Press to the Pinwheel block.

6. Refer to the block diagram at the top of the page and sew a unit from Step 4 to the top of the Step 5 unit. Sew the remaining Step 4 unit to the bottom of the of the Step 5 unit. Press to the Step 4 units.
