12" finished block

Fabric Colors: Black & White

Cutting Instructions

Black Fabric

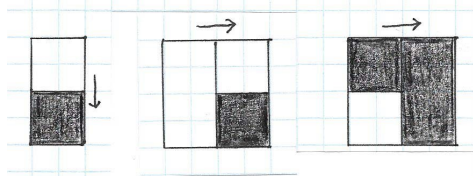
1. Cut 8 squares each 2-7/8" square
2. Cut 2 rectangles each 2-1/2 x 4-1/2"
3. Cut 6 square each 2-1/2" square

White Fabric

1. Cut 8 squares each 2-7/8" square
2. Cut 2 rectangles each 2-1/2 x 4-1/2"
3. Cut 6 square each 2-1/2" square

Sewing Sequence

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 8 white 2-7/8" squares.
2. Place the white squares right sides together with the 8 black 2-7/8" squares
3. Sew a scant 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line.
4. Cut apart on the diagonal line. Press to the black triangles.
5. Using 4 of the white 2-1/2" squares & 4 of the black 2-1/2" squares, sew them together as shown in the diagram below. Next add the appropriate rectangles to the side as shown in the diagram below.

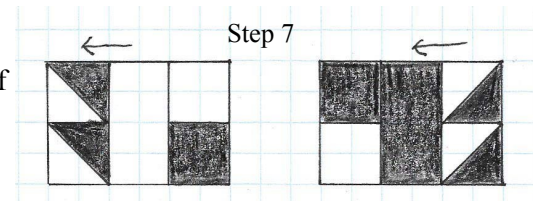


Arrows indicate pressing directions.

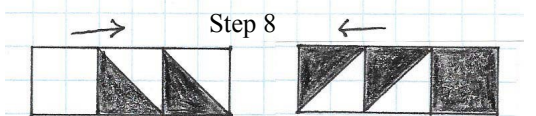
6. Sew the triangle units from Step 4 together as shown. Sew 4 sets of each. There are reverse directions so be sure to follow the diagram.



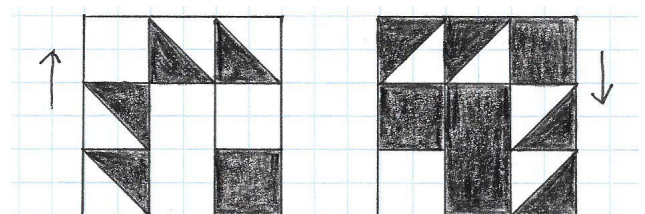
7. Place completed units as shown in the block diagram at top of the page. Add the units from Step 6 to the units from Step 5. Sew 2 sets of each.



8. Using the block diagram at top of the page, sew the black 2-1/2" squares and the white 2-1/2" squares to the proper side of the remaining units from Step 6. Sew 2 sets of each.



9. Sew the Step 8 units to the Step 7 units. Sew 2 sets of each. Complete the block using the block diagram as a guide.
