Union Squares

12" finished block

Fabric Colors: Monochromatic Blues using 2 values of blue with a neutral (tan, white, etc.) background fabric.

Cutting Instructions

Fabric 1 = Cut 1 square 4-1/2"

Cut 2 squares each 5-1/4" and divide in half diagonally twice

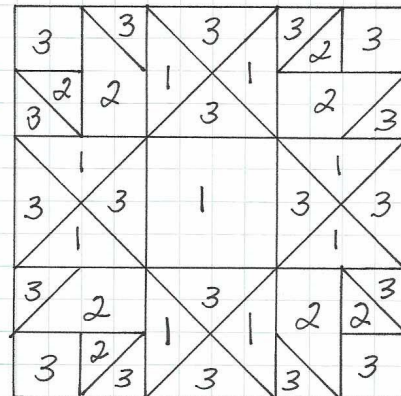
Fabric 2 = Cut 4 rectangles each 2-1/2" x 4-1/2":

Cut 2 squares each 2-7/8"

Fabric 3 = Cut 2 squares each 5-1/4" and divide in half diagonally twice

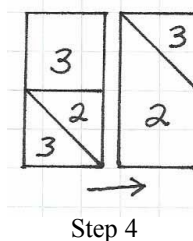
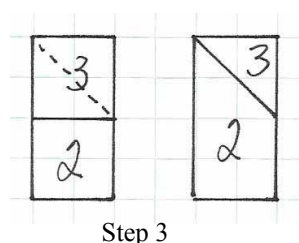
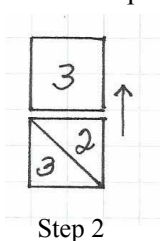
Cut 8 squares each 2-1/2"

Cut 2 squares each 2-7/8"

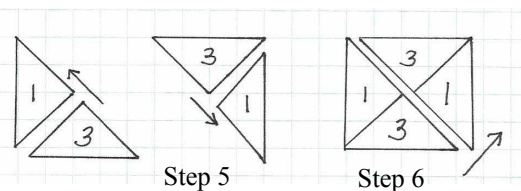


Sewing Sequence

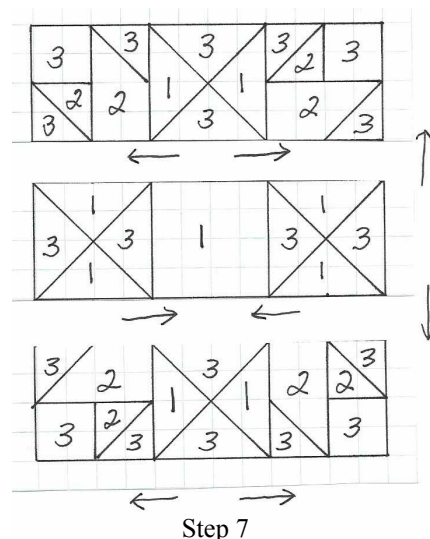
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2-7/8" square of #3, place right sides together with the 2-7/8" square of #2 and sew a scant 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press to the #2 fabric.
2. Sew a 2-1/2" #3 square to the units from step 1.
3. Using the magic corner method, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 4 of the 2-1/2" #3 squares, place on a #2 rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Press to the #3 fabric.
4. Sew the units from steps 2 & 3 together as shown below.



5. Sew the short sides of the large #1 and #3 triangles as shown below.
6. Sew the step 5 units together as shown below.



7. Sew the rows together as shown below and finish the block.
